Once an NPI is assigned it's not uncommon for providers to forget to maintain their NPPES information. NPPES is one of many sites that insurance carriers use to validate provider data. As your

career progresses and life brings new opportunities, it's important to ensure the NPPES site has accurate information about you.

Below are some common reasons to check and update your information:

- 1. Recent name change
- 2. Moved to a new practice location
- 3. Practicing in a new or additional state
- 4. Graduated from a specialty program

If any of the above scenarios have occurred, we highly recommend checking and updating your NPPES profile.
